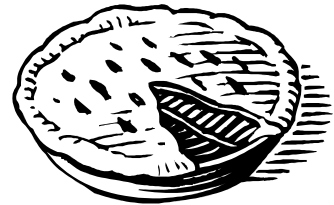


# High Altitude Baking Camp & Recipe Rescue

Submit a recipe (via email to [Kathy@pagosabakingcompany.com](mailto:Kathy@pagosabakingcompany.com)) that you've had trouble with at altitude, and three or four will be chosen to take through the conversion process to completed product.

Pagosa Baking Company will provide basic baking ingredients (all purpose flour, sugar, brown sugar, eggs, butter, vanilla, milk, cream, baking soda, baking powder, and yeast). There will also be a food scale for use and scales available for purchase.
